Date: January 2019

Kindergarten registration will be open from **Monday, February 4, 2019 through Monday, March 4, 2019**. If your child will be five (5) years old by September 1, 2019, he or she is eligible for enrollment in our kindergarten program. Registration can begin online at [www.millsd.us](http://www.millsd.us), under "District Info", then "New Student Registration".

**If you know of any families who have an eligible child and may not have received this letter, we would appreciate it if you would tell them about registration and advise them to contact the school and direct them to our Facebook page or our website.**


Once you have registered, you will be contacted to schedule a Kindergarten Registration Appointment in May. Please note that only a parent or legal guardian may register a kindergarten student. At that time, you will need to bring the following documentation with you:

1. Original, official birth certificate of student (we cannot accept a photocopy).
2. Student's current immunization records (copy may be obtained from your child's physician, or it can be faxed to 570-458-4715).
3. Custody Agreement (if applicable). ***This must be the most current, original document with the court seal.***
4. Proof of Residence in Millville Area School District. This should be something that would be sent to the address listed, regardless of who lives there. Some examples are:
  - Tax return indicating residency within the district.
  - Payment or proof of liability for payment for municipal or school taxes due to residency within the District.
  - Current utility bill indicating payment for a utility due to occupancy of a residence within the district.
  - The items can NOT be something that you are able to change the address of, such as driver's license, health/auto insurance documents (homeowners' or renters' documents okay), paystubs, etc.

If you do not have access to the Internet via a computer, please call the District Office at 570-458-5538, Option 3 during the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. to arrange for the use of a school computer on our campus or to request a kindergarten registration packet.

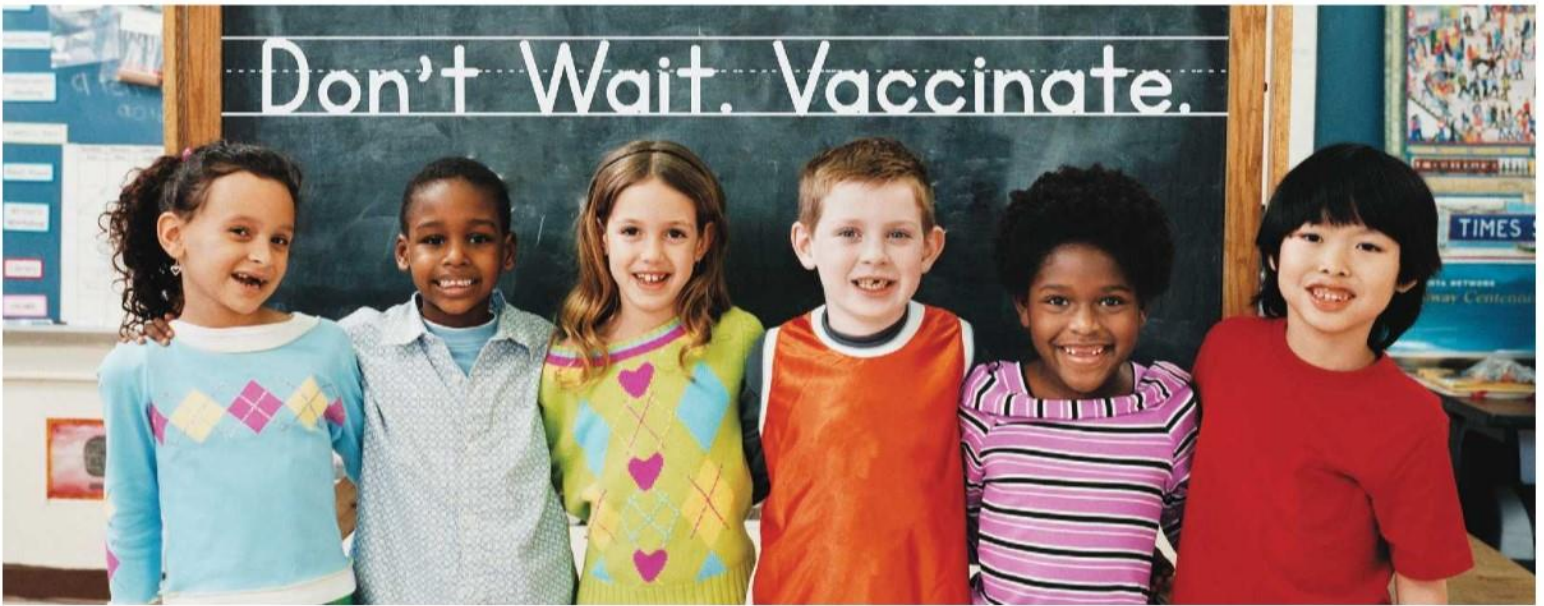

# Don't Wait. Vaccinate.



## Children starting Kindergarten need the following:

- ◆ 4 doses of tetanus\*, diphtheria\*, and acellular pertussis\* (1 dose on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- ◆ 4 doses of polio (4<sup>th</sup> dose on or after on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday & at least 6 months after previous dose given)
- ◆ 2 doses of measles\*\*, mumps\*\*, and rubella\*\*
- ◆ 3 doses of hepatitis B
- ◆ 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity

\*Usually given as DTP or DTaP or DT or Td

\*\*Usually given as MMR



## Children starting 7<sup>th</sup> Grade need the following:

- ◆ 2 doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)
  - ◆ First dose is given 11-15 years of age; a second dose is required at age 16 or entry into 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
  - ◆ If the dose was given at 16 years of age or older, only one dose is required.
- ◆ 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap)

## A child must have required vaccines or risk exclusion from school.

A child must have the required medically-appropriate vaccines or a plan to complete those vaccines or risk exclusion from school. A child may still obtain medical, religious or philosophical exemption from meeting the immunization requirements.
