

Millville Area Athletic Competition Protocols for Visiting Teams

The following steps will be taken to assist in the mitigation of the spread of Covid-19 during sporting events at Millville Area School District.

1. Visiting Teams Pre-Participation Checks:

- a. All athletes, Coaches, Officials, and team managers must successfully complete a Pre-Participation screening upon arrival.
- b. Within screenings, district personnel will assess student athletes' temperature, assess student athletes for characteristic symptoms of COVID-19, and assess student athletes for direct contact with a person with a confirmed positive COVID-19 diagnosis within fourteen (14) Days.
- c. Upon arriving at Millville Area School District, The Athletic Trainer/Athletic Director/Game Manager will check all athletes, coaching staff, etc... before they exit the bus and enter the Millville Area School District facilities.

2. Positive Testing:

- a. In the event that a student athlete is symptomatic and/or has had contact with a COVID-19 positive individual, he/she will be isolated from other student athletes.
- b. If a visiting student athlete presents with a temperature of 100.4 or greater, he/she will be isolated from other athletes for no less than 20 minutes after which, a second temperature screening will be taken.
- c. In the event that the second temperature screening of a visiting athlete yields a temperature of 100.4 degrees or more, the student athlete will be isolated from other students and staff. The student may not be permitted to enter the district facilities.
- d. If the player is kept from the athletic event the Head Coach, Referee, Millville School Administration, and the visiting school Athletic Director will be notified immediately by the Millville Athletic Director, Mark Barnes, of the quarantined athlete.

3. Spectators

- a. Millville Area School District will be allowing spectators within Millville Area facilities.
 - i. Consistent with the PaDOH, the Millville Area School District is limiting spectator capacity to 250 individuals for athletic events that are held in the district's outdoor facilities.
 - ii. Consistent with the PaDOH, the Millville Area School District is limiting spectator capacity to 25 individuals for athletic events that are held in the district's indoor facilities.
 - iii. The occupancy thresholds described above are inclusive of all athletes, coaches, game staff, medical trainer, security, administration, media, and spectators.
 - iv. Each athlete from the home team and visiting teams will be afforded with **TWO** reserved tickets per player. These tickets will be distributed to Millville Area student athletes prior to events. **TWO** tickets will be reserved for all visiting athletes that appear on rosters provided by visiting team.
 - v. Parents/Guardians/Guests of student athletes from the visiting team will provide give their child's name at the gate in order to gain admission into district athletic facilities.
 - vi. All spectators will be expected to pay general admission pricing to attend events.
 1. Depending upon the number of tickets that are allocated to students athletes, the district will permit additional general admission tickets to be made available to spectators. Once the occupancy/capacity thresholds are reached, additional spectators will not be admitted.

- b. Spectators will have their temperature checked before entering the stadium. In an abundance of caution, any spectator who presents with a body temperature of 100.4 or greater will not be permitted to enter the stadium
- c. While in attendance for district athletic events, ALL spectators, coaches, administration, and staff must wear an appropriate face covering consistent the PA Universal Face Covering Mandate implemented on July 1, 2020.
- d. While in attendance for district athletic events, ALL spectators, coaches, administration, and staff must demonstrate appropriate social distancing to the maximum extent possible when sitting in the bleachers, unless with family. The bleachers have been marked to delineate 6 feet distance between spectators.

4. Locker Rooms

- a. There will be no locker rooms available during the athletic event.

5. Restrooms

- a. There will be rest rooms available for all athletes and spectators during the event.
- b. There will also be handwashing stations for the athletes on the field so they can wash hands in a manner with CDC and PaDOH guidelines.

6. Athletes

- a. Athletes must maintain six feet apart of social distance or to the maximum extent possible while positioned on the sidelines. Additional benches will be supplanted in district facilities in order to ensure that the visiting team can maintain maximum social distance as well.
- b. All athletes are required to wear an appropriate face covering while positioned on sidelines awaiting participation in sport. However, athletes engaged in competitive sport are not required to wear a face covering for it may promote a safety risk to the athlete. Moreover, athletes will have a few minutes after leaving the physical activity to catch their breath before they are required to cover face again.
- c. Athletes are asked to refrain from handshakes with referees, opposing coaches and players, before and after the game.
