



## Millville Area School District Reopening Plan Options

The *Millville Area Phased School Health and Safety Plan* enables parents and guardians to choose which instructional plan is best for their child(ren). Below the characteristics of each model are provided for families so that they can make an informed decision. After careful consideration, parents and guardians should complete the *2020-21 Enrollment Form* which is located within Sapphire. In doing so, the MASD can begin to make the necessary preparations for the upcoming school year.
