



Dear Millville Families,

Today, November 20, 2020, the district received notice that a faculty member tested positive for COVID-19. In response, the district has enacted COVID-19 protocols which include: 1.) Contact with the CSIU-16 Rapid Response Team Representative; 2.) Consultation with the PA Department of Health; 3.) Communication with individuals who were in “close contact” with the COVID-19 positive faculty member within 48 hours prior to symptom onset; and 4.) Thorough cleaning and sanitizing of district classrooms. The number of individuals with whom the teacher was in "close contact" was very limited. The impacted individuals have been notified and instructed to quarantine for 14 days from the last day of contact.

At this point, the district has responded to the positive case in a manner consistent with the PaDOH in order to maintain the safety and welfare of all students, faculty, and staff. Administration, faculty and staff will maintain and enforce mitigation strategies employed by the MASD including: Maintaining social distance to the maximum extent possible, wearing appropriate face coverings, and cleaning and sanitizing hands when entering and leaving classrooms.

The district will continue to work closely with our students, faculty, staff, state health agencies, and families through these challenging situations.
