1—Community Garden—Miss Williamson had requested to create a Community Garden with the Environmental Club. It will be placed near the scoreboard outside the fence area of the baseball field. The students will grow tomatoes, cucumbers, potatoes, peas, carrots, string beans, peppers, grapes, strawberries, zucchini, lettuce, and pumpkins. They will can and donate the food to the local food bank. Jim shared he would be willing to donate raised beds and some fencing. We applied for a Farm to School grant to help support this project.
