

Important Athletic Update

PARENTS/GUARDIANS OF MILLVILLE JR/SR HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETES, January 5, 2021

On November 23rd, 2020, in an effort to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in the Commonwealth, the Pennsylvania Department of Health issued orders regarding out of state travel and occupancy. The new occupancy limitations state that we are limited to ten percent occupancy for indoor events. Due to this mitigation order, we will have to limit spectators at all athletic events.

1. Our Wrestling team is on a cooperative agreement with the Benton Area School District. Benton is not allowing any spectators at their events. They will have Wrestling streamed live on their YouTube channel.
2. Girls' Basketball will have two tickets allotted for senior athletes only. Due to occupancy restrictions, numbers do not allow for all parents to be admitted. Both the Junior Varsity and Varsity games will be streamed live on our Facebook page.
3. Since our Boys' Basketball team also has cheerleaders in attendance, we will be alternating the parents that will be in attendance for each game. For our first boys' home game, senior basketball players will be allotted two tickets for the game. For the next boys' home game, senior cheerleaders will be allotted two tickets for the game. The games/dates senior parents are allotted tickets are listed below. *****This reflects the new schedule due to the mitigation closure orders that suspended athletics until January 4th.** Both Junior Varsity and Varsity games will be streamed live on our Facebook page.
 - o **Senior Boys' Basketball Tickets: January 9th (Benton), January 22nd (Bucktail), February 2nd (Northwest), February 18th (Montgomery), February 23rd (Mifflinburg).**
 - o **Senior Cheerleader Tickets: January 19th (South Williamsport), January 28th (Bloomsburg), February 8th (Northumberland Christian), February 19th (Muncy), February 25th (Lourdes).**
4. Senior Night will be addressed as it gets closer and information will be provided.
5. For away games, please check with the visiting team concerning their spectator policies.

It is our desire to be as accommodating as possible, however, we are obligated to uphold these mitigation orders to keep our school community safe. We will continue to monitor numbers and will increase occupancy if/when permitted.
